**WHY:** We will be recruiting post-secondary students, recent graduates, journeyman level, and/or full performance level, and veterans using direct hire authority for multiple disciplines and grade levels, from GS-03 to GS-12, and equivalent wage grade positions. Depending on GS position/location selected for, promotion potential is to the GS-7, 8, 9, 11, or 12 level. On the spot interviews, letters of interest, and tentative job offers may be made to attendees during the event.

**PAY RANGE:** General Schedule: \$28,758 to \$115,430; Wage Grade: \$16.63 to \$40.14 per hour. Pay will be based on such factors as your qualifications, education, experience, training, duty location, and availability of funds.

## HOW TO REGISTER:

After your registration email is received, you will be sent a confirmation email with instructions and information on how to access the district. Registering for this event is not required but preferred.

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:** In order to be considered, please attach your resume, any license/certification documents, DD 214 member copy 4, Schedule A letter from your doctor, VA letter and/or most recent transcript(s) to the same email address: [CEMVN-Careers@usace.army.mil](mailto:CEMVN-Careers@usace.army.mil) where you registered. Be sure to bring a copy of all application documents with you to the job fair event.

**EVALUATIONS:** Candidates will be evaluated in accordance with the qualification and eligibility requirements set forth by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) located at <https://www.opm.gov/policy-data-oversight/classification-qualifications/general-schedule-qualification-standards/#url=Group-Standards>.

## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ All positions require the applicant to be a citizen of the United States.
- ◆ Male applicants born after December 31, 1959, are required to register for Selective Service prior to appointment.
- ◆ A trial or probationary period may be required.
- ◆ Some positions may require a valid driver's license.
- ◆ Some positions may require a security clearance to include fingerprinting.
- ◆ Some position may require temporary duty travel.
- ◆ Some position may require a Defense Acquisition Certification within 2 years of appointment.
- ◆ The following MAY be paid or offered: travel and relocation expenses, recruitment incentive, and/or student loan repayment.
- ◆ Promotion progression to the target position is contingent upon satisfactory completion of training requirements and continuous satisfactory performance.
- ◆ Post-secondary student appointments are term in nature and have the potential to convert into a permanent appointment in the competitive service.
- ◆ Selectee must obtain a passing score on the appropriate Administrative Careers with America (ACWA) assessment prior to appointment or conversion, if applicable.

**EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY:** The United States Government does not discriminate in employment on the basis of race, color, religion, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), national origin, political affiliation, sexual orientation, marital status, disability, genetic information, age, membership in an employee organization, retaliation, parental status, military service, or other non-merit factor.

**LOCATION ACCESS:** You will enter through the Prytania St. gate, (the district is located on the levee where Prytania and Leake meet). Access to the New Orleans District is restricted and requires a valid driver's license and your confirmation email for the job fair. The vehicle operator and individuals age 18 and over must process and be ready to present the following documents: valid vehicle registration, current vehicle insurance, and a valid driver's license at the visitor control center to obtain a visitor pass.
